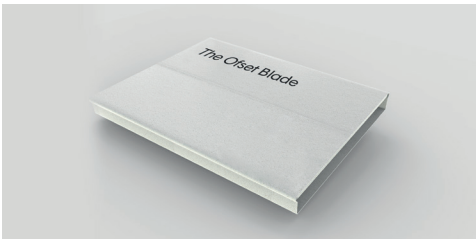


Delivery & Lifting

Every Blade rooflight is handmade and bespoke and will be delivered fully manufactured, wrapped and packed normally within a 15-25 working day timeline.

Instructions



- 1)** Rooflights can be very heavy requiring many people or specialised equipment onsite to move them. It is extremely important you have allowed for the weight and size implications of your Blade(s). Please cross reference the table in our Blade Design Tolerances guide to find out your skylight's correct weight and measurements. An average adult can lift 30kg.



- 2)** Offset will deliver the product to the kerbside, driveway or nearest accessible point on a curtain sided delivery vehicle.



- 3)** Rooflights must be lifted off the delivery vehicle and taken to the fitting area by the clients / builders / fitters, NOT by Offset. Clients must have in place enough people and/or equipment to carry out this procedure. Sometimes glazing trolleys can be used, which may need 'running mats' if the ground is uneven. If access is limited there can be a problem, particularly with properties that have no side access. Sometimes the product will need to be carried through the house, which could be a major problem if you have not allowed for hallways, stairs, small doors etc. Please make sure you have considered all issues BEFORE delivery takes place.

- 4)** The hardest part is getting the product(s) onto the roof. It can be dangerous lifting heavy windows up ladders. If your rooflights are over 150kg in weight, please speak to your builder to make sure they can cope with the lift or perhaps consider an assisted lift. One of our project managers can talk you through the process to see if your property is suitable for a 'spider crane' lift and also if the crane is within budget.

The spider crane runs on tracks which compact to 600mm but requires a standing area of 4m² to get products onto the roof. The Blade Spider crane option does not lift units 'over the house'.

The Blade Spider crane option costs from £995 plus VAT. The price includes a fully qualified operator and an assistant. Offset can also help organise 'over the house' cranes where required. Prices from £1495 plus VAT.

- 5)** Whether you are organising the lift yourself or Offset are providing a spider crane, please make sure your fitters or builders are onsite on the delivery day to help make the lifting and fitting process fluid.
